AppNoBusy -- Bring YAM out of busy state. (V2.0)

**TEMPLATE**

Terminates the busy state initiated by [APPBUSY](#).

**INPUTS**

**RETURNS**

RC is set to 1 if YAM is still busy.

**NOTES**

V2.4 introduced the concept of busy levels, which means that if [APPBUSY](#) is called several times in a row, an equal number of calls to AppNoBusy must be made for the application to return to normal state.

AppNoBusy is a "safe" command, i.e. it can be called even if the application is not busy at the time, causing no error.
