What is YAM?

YAM (short for **Yet Another Mailer**) is a MIME-compliant open-source Internet mailer written for AmigaOS-based computer systems. It supports multi-POP3, APOP, SMTP, TLSv1/SSLv3, multiple users, PGP, unlimited hierarchical folders, filters, a configurable GUI (based on [?MUI](#)) and an ARexx interface and many other features which are common for Mail User Agents ([?MUA](#)) today... ??

Features

As the development of YAM goes back to 1995 it is probably one of the most feature-rich applications on the Amiga platform. Especially the MUI-based user interface allowed to implement functionality which are commonly used in graphical mail user client on other platforms today. Furthermore, the support and compliance to the most recent [?RFCs](#) is one of the keystrength of YAM... ???
